3. As per record, Written Statement filed by defendant no.1&2 was taken on record on 18.10.2022 and right to file Replication qua defendant no.1&2 was ordered to be closed vide order dated 10.07.2024.

4. Vide order dated 01.12.2023, the right of the defendant no.3 & 4 to file Written Statement was closed. The said order further records that defendant no.5 to 7 have already given statement of no objection in the present suit.

5. The plaintiff has neither filed the Joint Schedule of the documents nor deposited the cost of Rs.2000/- with Delhi High Court Legal Services despite being granted the last and final opportunity vide last order dated 07.11.2024. It is stated by learned counsel for the plaintiff that his application under Order VI Rule 17 CPC is pending consideration before the Hon'ble Court. However, admittedly, there is no stay of the present proceedings by the Hon'ble Court. The plaintiff has not furnished any plausible explanation for non-compliance of the order dated 07.11.2024. Thus, further, cost of Rs.3000/- is imposed upon the plaintiff to be deposited with Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee and the last and final opportunity is granted to the plaintiff to comply the last order dated 07.11.2024.
