1. Learned counsel for proposed defendant no. 6 & 7 appeared and submitted that she had already filed the reply but further submitted that she is having no objection, if the application is allowed. At request, let copy of application be supplied on behalf of defendants no. 6 & 7 to learned counsel for plaintiff through e-mail on sharing the same.
2. Learned counsel for plaintiff submitted that defendant no. 2 is supporting the plaintiff's case and defendant no. 1 is not traceable.
3. Learned counsel appeared on behalf of defendant no. 3 appeared, accepted the notice and submitted that he has not received the copy of application. Plaintiff is directed to supply copy of this application to learned



counsel for defendant no. 3 through e-mail on sharing the same. Let reply be filed three weeks after receiving the copy, with advance copy to the opposite party and rejoinder thereto, if any, may also be filed within two weeks thereafter.

4. PF not filed for service of defendants no. 4 & 5. Let notice be issued to defendants no. 4 & 5 through all approved modes, on taking necessary steps on behalf of the plaintiff for the next date of hearing.

5. Learned counsel for plaintiff submitted that defendant no. 5 is presently in India who was residing in USA and as requested let process be also given *dasti*.

6. Let reply be filed within four weeks, with advance copy to the opposite party and rejoinder thereto, if any, may also be filed within two weeks thereafter so that pleadings may be completed in this IA before the next date of hearing.

7. Put up for completion of pleadings on 23.03.2026.
