W.P.(C) 10213/2019

The present writ petition assails the award dated 07.05.2018 passed by the learned Labour Court-XIX, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi rejecting the petitioner's claim by holding that he was not able to prove that his services were ever terminated by respondent no.2/management.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the learned Labour Court has, while rejecting the petitioner's claim, failed to appreciate that the petitioner had been working for the last many years with the respondent/management and merely because he was terminated without being given any termination letter, it could not mean that he had not been terminated.
