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1. Pursuant to the order dated 24.11.2022, the appellant has filed an affidavit in which it has been categorically stated by him that he had falsely implicated in the matter as he had refused to pay the sum of Rs.50,000/- demanded by the then Investigating Officer - Shri Ishwar Chandra, Sub-Inspector, Police Station No. 28700447, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal Cell, North, Timarpur, Delhi.
2. In respect of his other plea, that the 'Legal Aid Counsel' who was representing him before the learned Tribunal did not effectively defend his case, the appellant has already filed a copy of his complaint made against the said counsel to Delhi Legal Aid Services Authority (DLSA), Tis Hazari Court on 30.07.2022.
3. Upon the appellant taking steps, issue notice to the respondents through all permissible modes. Reply, if any, be filed within six weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within four weeks,



thereafter.

4. In the light of this stand taken by the appellant, no coercive steps be taken against the appellant in the ongoing execution proceedings in respect of the impugned award.
