CRL.M. A. 136/2022-INTERIM RELEASE OF PETITIONER NO.1

This is an application filed seeking interim release of the petitioner No.1 (Mohammad Sahil) from custody of the respondent No.1 (Foreigners Regional Registration Office) (FRRO) during the pendency of the writ petition.

It is admitted by the respondents that the petitioner No.1 is in the detention centre of respondent No.2 (FRRO).

The petitioner No.1 has filed with the petition, a photo copy of his Adhaar Card bearing No. 5130 0903 5316. Along with the petition, the petitioner No.1 has also filed photo copy of his passport bearing No. R3175333 dated 16.10.2017 valid upto 15.10.2027. As per the passport, the address of petitioner No.1 is C-528, Gali No.3, New Seemapuri, Delhi –



110095, India.

The *prima facie* view is that the petitioner No.1 is an Indian citizen. For the said reasons, the criminal application No. 136/2022 is allowed and the petitioner No.1 is directed to be released from the detention centre of petitioner No.2 (FRRO) till further orders.

The petitioner No.1 shall report to the Foreigner Cell, Shahdara District, Delhi every Monday at 11 AM and mark his presence. He shall not be kept waiting for more than an hour.

He shall give his mobile number and the same shall be operational throughout the pendency of the writ petition.
