1. Learned Counsel for the Appellant seeks to rely upon the judgment dated 16.02.2009 of the Supreme Court in the matter of ***Commissioner of Customs (Preventive) v. M/s Aafloat Textiles (I) Pvt. Ltd. and Ors. (2009) 11 SCC 18***, to submit that once there was a finding of fraud, the learned Trial Court could not have proceeded further and granted any relief to the Petitioner.
2. Issue Notice. On steps being taken, let Notice be served to the Respondents *via* all modes, *dasti* as well. An affidavit of service be filed within ten days.
3. List on 07.10.2024.
4. In the meantime, learned Counsel for the parties shall file their respective written synopsis, not exceeding three pages each, at least three days before the next date of hearing, along with the compilation of



judgments, if any, they wish to rely upon.

4.1 All judgments sought to be relied upon by the learned Counsel for the parties shall be filed with an index which also sets out the relevant paragraph numbers and the proposition of law that it sets forth.
