In terms of order dated 09.02.2021, the medical status report has not been received from the Superintendent, Central Jail concerned. However, in as much as it is submitted on behalf of the CBI that a copy thereof has been received, copy of which is also stated to have been supplied by the CBI to the learned counsel for the applicant. The copy of the same has been placed on record by the learned counsel for the applicant which has been perused. As per which, it is indicated that the applicant was taken to AIIMS on 12.02.2021 in the Haematology Department where the doctor examined him and advised him blood investigation and surgery opinion for haemorrhoids and he was also prescribed with the oral medications.

It has been submitted on behalf of the applicant that he has been suffering from thalassemia. As per the status report dated 13.02.2021 that



has been received from the Medical Officer, In-charge, Central Jail No.10, Rohini, the applicant has been provided a date of 24.03.2021 for his blood investigation from AIIMS with the review in the surgery unit of Dr. BSA Hospital on the date 15.02.2021 for his complaint of haemorrhoids. It has been stated through the report that the applicant's general condition is stable and satisfactory and all the prescribed medications are being provided to him from the Jail Dispensary.

In as much as the submission made on behalf of the applicant is that he is suffering from thalassemia, qua which, as per the medical report dated 13.02.2021 received from the Medical Officer, In-charge, Central Jail No.10, it is indicated that he was fixed for a review in haematology department on 12.02.2021, it is essential that the date of examination in relation to the blood investigation is preponed.

The Medical Superintendent, AIIMS is thus directed to ensure that the blood investigation of the applicant is conducted expeditiously by the date 28.02.2021 and a report in relation thereto be sent to this Court through the Medical Officer, In-charge of the Central Jail No.10, Rohini, Delhi. The Superintendent, Jail No.10, Rohini shall ensure that the applicant is taken for the medical examination of his blood investigation to AIIMS expeditiously.

The said report is called of the medical condition of the applicant from the concerned Superintendent Jail for the date 03.03.2021.
