CRL.M.A. 1350/2023 (extn. of interim suspension of sentence)

1. This is an application for extension of interim bail as granted by this Court vide order dated 23.12.2022 .
2. This Court on 23.12.2022. taking into account the medical report from Senior Medical Officer In-Charge, Central -10, Rohini Court, New Delhi granted the interim bail till 23.01.2023 subject to certain conditions which are as follows:-



(i) The appellant shall remain only at Kanpur address i.e. LIG-27, Jarauli-1, Barra Kanpur Nagar, U.P.;

(ii) The appellant shall remain available on mobile number i.e. 7275920742, which he undertakes to keep operational during the pendency of the present appeal;

(iii) The appellant shall further remain in touch telephonically with SI Ravi on mobile number i.e. 9871680807 on the first Monday of every month;

(iv) In the event of change of his residential address/ contact details, the appellant shall promptly inform the same to the I.O./SHO, P.S. PS Makhi, Unnao, U.P.;

(v) The appellant shall remain present in the Court as and when the appeal is taken up for hearing;

(vi) The appellant shall not in any manner misuse his liberty;

(vii) The appellant shall remain available on Mobile No.- 7275920742, and shall drop a PIN on the Google map to ensure that his location is available to the Investigating Officer;

(viii) The appellant shall not be in touch with the co-accused and shall not make any effort to threaten or tamper with the prosecution witnesses;

(ix) The appellant shall not indulge in any act or omission that is unlawful or that would prejudice the proceedings in pending case.

(x) The appellant shall surrender before the Superintendent Jail, Central Jail No 10, Rohini, Delhi on or before 23rd January, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the diagnostic report dated 29.12.2022, the parameters of liver function are



abnormal. It has been submitted that Bilirubin count is beyond the permissible limit. It has further been submitted that as per the medical report dated 16.01.2023 also, the parameters are not in control.

4. I have seen the said medical records.
5. I consider that as per the parameters in the medical report shown, there is no ground to extend the interim bail as the condition can be taken care of in the Jail itself. Hence, there is no ground made out for extension of interim bail and thus, the present application stands dismissed. However, the Superintendent Jail, Central -10, Rohini Court, New Delhi is directed to provide a sufficient and adequate medical treatment to the accused-petitioner as per rules.
6. In view of the above, the present application stands disposed of.
