Pursuant to proceedings dated 10.12.2020, the medical status report dated 21.12.2020 has been received from the Superintendent Jail, Delhi. As per which, the haemoglobin level of the applicant/ appellant have improved to 11 mg/dl with the normal range being 12-15 mg/dl. It is also reported that the applicant's bilirubin is 3.6 with the normal range being 0.3 – 1.2 mg/dl which is stated to be due to break down of RCBs for which, Gastroenterology Department of GB Pant Hospital has advised blood investigation with oral medication and blood investigation has been done at GB Pant Hospital. It is however reported that the remaining LFT are within a normal range and that the applicant does not require any hospitalization qua his current medical condition and he has been advised further blood investigation and ultrasound of whole abdomen to assess his improvement on the date 22.12.2020, qua which, the status report is yet to be received,



which is called for for the next date of hearing.

Furthermore, in as much as learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the appellant has also been diagnosed with thalassemia. The updated medical condition of the applicant after examination of the appellant after receipt of this order be sent by the Superintendent Jail, Delhi for the next date. It is further submitted on behalf of the applicant that during the period that the applicant is quarantined after he has been taken to hospital, no treatment and care is provided to him. The Superintendent Jail where the applicant is lodged shall ensure that adequate treatment and care be provided to the applicant at all time even whether he is in a stage of quarantine or not.

It is specified in the report dated 21.12.2020 by the Medical Officer, In-charge, Central Jail No.10 that as regards the splenomegaly, the applicant's health condition is presently not life-threatening.

The report is called for from the Superintendent Jail, Delhi for the date 18.01.2021.

The date 12.01.2021 is cancelled.
