1. Although by virtue of the order dated 04.10.2023, the respondent is being paid interim maintenance of Rs.40,000/-, having regard to what is stated in ground 'u' of the appeal, we are presently inclined to increase the maintenance to Rs.50,000/- per month. This has also been done as the respondent is in custody of the child who is about nine (9) years of age.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant says that the direction issued will be complied with.
3. Since learned counsel for the appellant says that there is a possibility that the parties could arrive at an amicable settlement, we are inclined to refer the parties to the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre [in short, "Centre"].

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4. Accordingly, parties and their respective counsel will present themselves before the Centre on 23.08.2024, at 03:00 PM.
5. The Mediator will file a report prior to the next date of hearing.
6. List the matter before this Court on 03.12.2024.
7. Meanwhile, counsel for the parties will file written submissions, not exceeding three (3) pages each, at least five (5) days before the next date of hearing.
