1. The instant appeal under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 on behalf of the appellants seeking the following reliefs:

“a Set aside order dated 05.10.2023, PASSED BY DR. TARUN SHEHRAWAT DISTRICT SHAHDARA, KARKARDOOMA COURTS, DELHI IN MACT NO 183 OF 2016.

b) Issue any order or further order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.”



2. Heard.
3. Issue notice of the appeal and the accompanying applications to the respondent through all permissible modes on filing PF within one week.
4. Since, the matter requires consideration, this Court is of the view that subject to the appellants' deposition of the 25% of the compensation amount along with interest as per the impugned order dated 5th October, 2023 before the Registrar General of this Court within a period of four weeks, the operation of the impugned judgment and award shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing. The amount so deposited by the appellants shall be invested in an interest bearing FDR in an auto renewal mode.
5. List on 20th August, 2024 before Joint Registrar (Judicial) for completion of service and pleadings.
