This is a petition under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of the complaint case bearing No.31713/2019 under Section 138 and 141 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, stated to be pending before the Court of learned JMFC, South District, Saket along with all the proceedings emanating therefrom.
4. The petitioner is seeking quashing of proceedings on the ground that she was neither the Director, Signatory nor the in-charge of the accused



Company at the time of the alleged offence, having resigned on 01.09.2018 as evidenced by DIR-12.

5. Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant has failed to make any specific averments attributing the liability to her under Section 141 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and that the cheques in question were issued solely by the Company.
