1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The matter has been received by way of transfer.

C.M. APPL. 19424/2026 (praying for disposing of the petition due to settlement and cancellation of NBWs)

3. The present application under Section 151 of the CPC filed on behalf of the respondent/applicant seeks the following prayers: -

“It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that kindly disposing off the petition in terms of the settlement dated 13.03.2026 and cancel the non-bailable warrant against the respondent, in the interest of justice.”

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent/applicant submits that the matter has been settled with the petitioner before the learned Executing Court on 13.03.2026 by way of a settlement. It is submitted that as per the said settlement dated 13.03.2026, respondent has to pay a settlement



amount of Rs.12,50,000/- in 3 installments, and the last instalment is payable on or before 22.05.2026. It is further pointed out that, in terms of the aforesaid agreement, the first installment of Rs.4,00,000/- has been paid.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner/non-applicant, who appears on an advance notice, submits that the matter may be listed subsequent to 22.05.2026 in order to ensure that the respondent abides by the terms of settlement before the learned Executing Court.

6. In these circumstances, re-notify on 28.05.2026, before the Roster Bench.

7. In the meantime, non-bailable warrants issued against the respondent *vide* order dated 12.02.2026 shall remain in abeyance till the next date of hearing.

8. Copy of the order be sent to the concerned SHO for necessary information and compliance.

9. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court *forthwith*.
