6. This is an application under Section 430 BNSS for suspension of sentence dated 26.11.2024 passed by the learned ASJ (POCSO) in SC No.356/2020.
7. Vide the impugned judgment dated 30.08.2024, the appellant has been convicted under Section 354/354B/376AB of IPC and under Section 6 & 10 of POCSO Act and vide order dated 26.11.2024 the appellant has been sentenced as under:-

- (a) For offence under Section 6 of POCSO Act, convict is sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for the period of twenty years and fine of Rs. 15,000/- and in default of payment of fine SI for one year.*
- (b) For offence under Section 10 of POCSO Act, convict is sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for the period of five years and fine of Rs. 5,000/- and in default of payment of fine SI for one year.*

8. Issue notice. Notice accepted by the learned APP appearing for the State who seeks time to file the status report.
9. Notice be also issued to the prosecutrix through the Investigating Officer (IO).
10. Status report be filed before the next date of hearing.
11. Nominal roll of the appellant be requisitioned from the Jail Superintendent.
