1. The learned counsels for the parties have drawn the attention of this Court to the Order dated 25.11.2021 passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in EFA(OS) 05 of 2008, **CE Construction Ltd. v. Ajay Relan & Ors.** The said appeal was withdrawn by CE Construction Ltd., the appellant therein, stating that the arguments in the pending application, that



is I.A. No. 20535 of 2014, would be addressed before this Court. The Hon'ble Division Bench has further directed that the report prepared by Mr. Joy Tirkey, Deputy Commissioner of Police (Crime), Delhi Police, be placed before this Court.

2. However, a perusal of the record of the Suit and the Execution Petition reveals that the said report has not been placed by the Registry before this Court. The Registry is directed to do the needful at the earliest.

3. The Hon'ble Division Bench has further directed that the copies of the said report be made available to the parties, who may be granted an opportunity to file their objections to the same if they so desire.

4. The learned counsels for the parties submit that they have received the copies of the report. The parties shall be at liberty to file their respective objections, if they so desire, within a period of four weeks from today, after supplying copies thereof to the other parties.

5. The Decree Holder in EX. P. 92 of 2019 is directed to file short synopsis of his arguments alongwith a convenience compilation of documents and judgments sought to be relied upon within the same period. The contesting respondents shall also file their arguments along with a convenience compilation of any other documents and judgments that they wish to rely upon, within four weeks thereafter.
