I.A. 15586/2025 (Condonation of delay)

1. Having heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiff and for the reasons stated in the application, the same stands allowed. The delay of 75 days in re-filing the plaint stands condoned.
2. The application stands disposed of.

CS(OS) 417/2025

I.A. 15585/2025 (under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 of CPC)

1. Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiff.
2. The plaint be registered as a suit. Summons of the suit as well as notice of the accompanying application bearing I.A. 15585/2025 be issued to the defendants by all permissible modes on filing of process fee. Affidavit of service be filed within two weeks.



3. The summons shall indicate that the written statements must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of the summons. The defendants shall also file affidavits of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statements shall not be taken on record.
4. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replications thereto within thirty days after filing of the written statements. The replications shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendants, failing which the replications shall not be taken on record.
5. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.
6. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.
7. List before the concerned Joint Registrar for taking up necessary further steps and for completion of pleadings in accordance with extant rules on 23.09.2025.
8. Thereafter, let the matter be listed before the Court on the date to be assigned by the concerned Joint Registrar.
