1. The present appeal has been filed under Rule V Chapter II of the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018, against the order dated 17th January, 2025 passed by the learned Joint Registrar (Judicial), closing the evidence of the defendants.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the defendants submits that the learned Joint Registrar (Judicial), ignored the fact that the witness was suffering from Jaundice, due to which, he could not attend the hearing fixed on 18th December, 2024 before the learned Joint Registrar (Judicial). Further, it was not possible for DW-1 to appear through Video Conferencing ("VC"), due to his medical condition.
3. It is further submitted that it was not feasible for the learned Local



Commissioner to conduct the evidence through VC, as there was no coordinator at point for recording evidence.

4. None appears for the plaintiff when the matter is called out.
5. Accordingly issue notice to the plaintiff by all modes, returnable on 26th March, 2025.
