The nominal roll shows that as on 21.12.2016, the appellant has undergone 1 year, 9 months and 14 days of incarceration and after accounting for provisional remission earned by him, the remaining sentence is 1 year, 11 months and 21 days. The jail conduct of the appellant has been found to be satisfactory.

Since the appeal is not likely to be heard early, the remaining sentence of the appellant shall remain suspended during the pendency of the appeal subject to:



- i) his furnishing personal bond with one surety in the sum of Rs.20,000/- to the satisfaction of the Trial Court;
 - ii) he shall provide his mobile phone number to the Trial Court at the time of his release, which shall be kept in working condition at all times. The same shall not be changed without prior intimation to the Trial Court; and
 - iii) he shall attend each & every date of hearing of the appeal.
