1. It is submitted that the captioned IAs are coming up for

2. It is submitted that the captioned IA was already disposed
off vide order dated 26.03.2025. Registry to take note of
the same.

3. Perusal of record shows that written statement alongwith affidavit of admission/denial of documents were already filed on behalf of defendant no.1.
4. Perusal of record further shows that replication alongwith affidavit of admission/denial of documents were already filed on behalf of plaintiff qua defendant no.1.
5. No affidavit of admission/denial has been filed on behalf of defendant no.1 qua documents of plaintiff which were filed vide diary no.2454447/2024 despite giving last opportunity. Some more time has been sought. In the interest of justice, one more opportunity is granted to the defendant no.1 for filing affidavit of admission/denial of documents within two weeks subject to cost of Rs.5,000/- to be paid to the plaintiff. Cost not paid, same be paid on or before next date of hearing.
6. No written statement and affidavit of admission/denial of documents has been filed on behalf of defendant no.2. Time sought. Let same be filed as per law with advance copy to the opposite party, who may file replication and affidavit of admission/denial of documents thereafter as per law.
7. Reply to the captioned IA filed on behalf of defendant no.1 vide diary no.5683959/2024 has not come on record till date. Let appropriate steps be taken as per law to get the same placed on record within two weeks.
8. At request of Ld. Counsel for plaintiff, Ld. Counsel for defendant no.1 has submitted that he will supply copy of reply to the captioned IA during the course of the day.

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Let the same be supplied accordingly and thereafter, rejoinder to the said reply be filed within four weeks.



9. No reply to the captioned IA has been filed on behalf of defendant no.2. Let the same be filed within four weeks as last opportunity and rejoinder thereto be filed within two weeks thereafter.
10. Let the pleadings be completed as per law.
11. Re-notify the matter for completion of pleadings and further proceedings on **15th September, 2025**.
