Mr. Rakesh Sharma, Superintendent from Land & Development, Ministry of Urban Development is present with the summoned record. He has filed attested copies of the summoned record running into 41 pages. Copies supplied to learned counsel for the plaintiff and the other defendants. Mr. Rakesh Sharma submits that the file of the suit of the case contains more pages but he has filed the photocopies of the documents which are relied upon by defendant No.2. Examination of Mr. Rakesh Sharma will not serve any purpose. In case the plaintiff or the other defendants think that there is some other document in the file of L&DO which has not been produced / filed by defendant No.2, they can make separate prayer to

Matter is also listed today for decision on the point whether defendant No.2 may be permitted to examine his witness Ms. Poonam Kaur Sethi before his own examination. Learned counsel for defendant No.2 agrees that in case he is not in a position to examine defendant No.2 on the next date, he will move appropriate application in this regard. Learned counsel for defendant No.2 has supplied copy of power of attorney to learned counsel for the other parties. Learned counsel for defendant No.5 submits that copy of the documents filed along with the written statement be also supplied to him. Learned counsel for defendant No.2 submits that copies were already supplied to the previous learned counsel. Learned counsel for defendant No.10 submits that to avoid controversy, he will supply the documents to learned counsel for defendant No.5. As and when an application is moved by any of the party or any documents are filed, service should be effected upon all other parties through their learned counsel (plaintiff as well as defendant)
