1. This application has been filed by petitioner seeking directions to bring minor child to Delhi during ongoing summer vacations in terms of settlement deed.
2. The relevant part of the settlement is as under:



a. At present, the Petitioner no. 1 is residing in Dubai with the minor child Hridhan. It was agreed by the said settlement agreement that the Petitioner no. 1 shall have the custody and the Petitioner no. 2 shall have the visitation rights of the minor son over the weekends from Saturday morning till Sunday evening. However, due to the change in circumstances as the child is currently staying and studying in Dubai, the Petitioner no. 1 undertakes to give unsupervised custody of the child to the Petitioner no. 2 for a period of 48 days every year during the vacations/holidays of the child, either in one stretch or in parts, which, unless otherwise agreed, shall include the entirety or part of the following time periods:

Summer Vacation

Winter Vacation

Other Holidays, such as festivals

In case Hridhan is unwell or has medical issues during the time period(s) for which his custody is agreed to be with the Petitioner no. 2 in a given year, such lost days shall be added up and compensated in the year of occurrence of such eventuality itself, and in no case later than the year following the occurrence of any such eventuality.

3. Upon querying counsel for petitioner as to whether they have approached the respondent or counsel for respondent, he states that they have not. Accordingly, counsel for petitioner undertakes to approach *Ms. Arpita Rai*, the counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent, in order to apprise her of the request made in this application.



4. *Ms.. Arpita Rai*, Advocate on behalf of counsel for respondent, shall take instructions from respondent and convey the same to the petitioner within one week by way of a written communication.
5. Application is, therefore, disposed of.
6. Petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application, in case, compliance is not made with the settlement arrived at.
