ORDER

1. The present petition has been filed seeking direction to the respondents to extend the time limit for the petitioner to process his application form for the Academic Year 2025-2026.
2. Mr. Neeraj Shekhar, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner's college is an institution intending to start BBA and BCA courses in the Academic Year 2025-2026 as per norms laid down by the respondent no. 1/AICTE.



3. He submits that the AICTE issued a public notice dated 04.11.2024 initiating the approval process for the Academic Year 2025-2026, inviting applications through the National Single Window System(NSWS). The deadline for submission of application was extended to 28.02.2025.
4. He submits that time was further extended by the respondent till 30.06.2025 and all the documents have been uploaded by the petitioner and the requisite payment has also been made but the said payment has not been accepted though the same was deposited prior to 30.06.2025.
5. He submits that the portal of respondent no.1/AICTE is still reflecting that the payment is under process and screenshot of the website will be filed by the petitioner within a period of one week. Let needful be done as undertaken.
6. In view of the above, issue notice. Mr. Devvrat Yadav, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent no.1/AICTE accepts notice. Likewise, Mr. Anuj Kapoor, learned counsel for the respondent no.2 accepts notice.
7. Let counter affidavit be filed within a period of two weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of one week thereafter.
8. Re-notify on 05.08.2025.
