Learned senior counsels for the petitioners submit that as per instructions received from the petitioners, the petitioners shall appear through video conferencing mode before the learned Special Judge (CBI)-10, Rouse Avenue Courts on 17.12.2022. However, it has been submitted that the said appearance may not amount to submission to jurisdiction of the



court and shall be without prejudice to all the contentions in the pending petitions, including the objections pertaining to jurisdiction and service of the summons. Learned senior counsels also submit that till the decision of the present petitions, the petitioners may not be required to seek bail or furnish any bond pursuant to such appearance.

Mr.D.P.Singh, learned Special PP for CBI submits that since the petitioners shall be appearing through VC, there is no need of passing any direction regarding furnishing any bail bond.

In terms of the submissions made by learned senior counsels for the petitioners at bar, let the petitioners appear through video conferencing modes before the learned Special Judge (CBI)-10, Rouse Avenue Courts on 17.12.2022. However, the question as to the submission to jurisdiction shall remain open. The petitioner shall be at liberty to raise the objections pertaining jurisdiction and service of summons. Needless to say, since the petitioners will be appearing through VC, there will be no occasion of furnishing any bail bond.

Learned trial court in view of the difference in time zone, is requested to take up the matter at 2.30 p.m.
