1. The plaintiff and the defendant no.1 have settled their disputes in mediation proceedings before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre ("Mediation Centre").
2. The Settlement Agreement dated 30th April, 2025, (hereinafter "Settlement Agreement"), which bears the digital signatures of the authorised representatives of the plaintiff and the defendant no.1, has been placed on record.
3. A sum of Rs.6,00,000/- has already been paid by the defendant no.1 to the plaintiff.
4. I have perused the terms of the Settlement Agreement and do not find anything unlawful therein.
5. Parties shall remain bound by the terms of the Settlement Agreement.
6. *Qua* defendant no.2, the mediation proceedings are still underway and

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the defendant no.3 has already been proceeded against *ex parte vide* order dated 14th February, 2025.

7. Accordingly, the suit is decreed *qua* defendant no.1 in terms of the Settlement Agreement. The Settlement Agreement shall form part of the decree.
