The petitioners are aggrieved by the order dated 03.10.2019 passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal ('Tribunal' for short) dismissing OA No. 2942/2019 filed by the petitioners herein. Mr.Dhingra, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a copy of the order has not been supplied to them despite repeated requests having been made to this effect. He further submits that the examination/recruitment test is to be conducted on



20.10.2019 (Sunday) and that the same may be stayed.

Mr. Naresh Kaushik, learned counsel who enters appearance on advance copy on behalf of UPSC submits that the Recruitment Rules as revised on 16.02.2018 are under challenge and thus he opposes the grant of interim relief to the petitioners.

Since we do not have the benefit of having perused the impugned order passed by the Tribunal, which we hope would be provided to the petitioner shortly, if not already provided, renotify on 07.11.2019 for preliminary hearing of this writ petition.

We make it clear that the selection process would be subject to the outcome of this writ petition.
