Today's Court proceedings are conducted through physical/hybrid mode.

CM APPL. 62091/2023

This is an application filed by applicants seeking their substitutions as LR's of deceased petitioner who is stated to have died on 22.08.2023. A copy of the death certificate is annexed to the application. The details of legal heirs is given in para 3 of the application which includes wife, one son and one daughter.

It is submitted by the counsel of the petitioner/applicant that apart from the legal heirs as mentioned in the application, there is no other class-I surviving legal heirs of deceased petitioner.

By way of its reply the application is opposed by counsel for respondents/ MCD on the ground that petitioner/applicant has not produced



any legal heirs certificate to prove that there are no other legal heirs of deceased petitioner.

In view of the statement made by counsel for the petitioner/applicant that there are no other Class-I surviving legal heirs of the petitioner except the one as mentioned in the application, the application deserves to be allowed. The Legal heirs of deceased petitioners are permitted to be brought on record. The amended memo of parties filed with the application be taken on record.
