1. The present application has been filed by the applicant/petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India r/w Section 151 of CPC seeking suspension of his sentence till the final disposal of the present petition.
2. Notice issued.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents accepts notice and has opposed the present application on the ground that there are serious allegations against the applicant/petitioner. Therefore, his sentence may not be suspended.



4. It is not in dispute that the petitioner has been sentenced to suffer Simple Imprisonment for nine months and has been dismissed from service. The applicant/ petitioner was taken into custody on 03.08.2022. Thus, he has completed more than four months of sentence.

5. However, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, we hereby suspend the sentence of the petitioner subject to his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.15,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the competent authority.

6. The application is, accordingly, disposed of.
