ORDER

CM APPL. 25815/2024 (Delay)

1. This is an application seeking condonation of delay of 37 days in filing the review petition.
2. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed.
3. Application stands disposed of.

REVIEW PET. 195/2024

4. This is a review petition filed by the applicant/petitioner in person seeking review of the order dated 23.02.2024 whereby the petitioner was granted 50% of the back wages whereas according to the petitioner she was entitled to full back wages. The applicant/petitioner has argued the merits of the matter which were

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not subject matter of the issue which was decided in the order dated 23.02.2024. The order dated 23.02.2024 was restricted only to the back wages for the first termination which was held to be illegal by the Competent Authority. This Court had evaluated the facts as urged by the applicant/petitioner as also by the learned counsel appearing for the respondents and had passed an order on that basis, granting 50% back wages. The petitioner seeks to reargue the same issue once again which is not permissible under Order 47 (1) r/w under Section 151 CPC, 1908. No error apparent on the face of the record has been pointed out.

5. In that view of the matter, the review petition is dismissed.

CM APPL. 29761/2024 (Exemption)

6. Exemption allowed subject to all just exceptions.

7. The application stands disposed of.

CM APPL. 29670/2024

8. This is an application seeking directions to the respondents to place on record the complete record pertaining to the petitioner's termination.

9. Issue notice.

10. Ms. Kaul accepts notice on behalf of non-applicants/respondent nos. 2 and 3. Ms. Kaul submits that even without the order of the Court, the respondents are bringing the original file to the court on every date.

11. Applications stands disposed of by directing the respondents to bring the original file pertaining the petitioner on each date.

12. Ms. Monga is entitled to inspect the original file on the next



date of hearing in Court before the matter is taken up.

CM APPL. 29760/2024

13. This is an application seeking permission to file additional documents on record other than what has already been filed before the Court in relation to the first termination dated 05.06.2020.

14. Issue notice.

15. Ms. Kaul accepts notice who seeks some time to file reply to the same. Ms. Kaul submits that she does not have the complete copy of the application along with the documents.

16. Ms. Monga is directed to furnish a copy of the application along with the documents which she seeks to place on record during the course of the day.

17. Reply be filed within four weeks with an advance copy to the petitioner. Rejoinder, thereto if any, be filed within four weeks, thereafter, with an advance copy to learned counsel for the respondent.

18. List on the date fixed i.e. 20.09.2024.
