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1. The first order of exoneration was passed on 31st December, 2015 in favour of the petitioner and the same was affirmed in the revisional jurisdiction, the remedy which was exhausted at the behest of respondents.
2. The contentions raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner are that the Railway Protection Rules, 1987 does not provide for the further revision or *suo moto* action in the matter. It is further urged that even if it is presumed that there are powers to *suo moto* review, still such proceedings cannot be taken out after the lapse of period of one year from the date of the order of exoneration.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents seeks time to show the source power of the respondents and also undertakes to produce the original records before this Court.
