1. It is submitted that the captioned IA is coming up for
hearing before the Hon'ble Court on 20.04.2023.

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1. Perusal of record shows that written statement alongwith
affidavit of admission/denial of documents already filed
on behalf of the defendant no.4.

2. As per office noting, written statement and affidavit of

10. The defendant no.1 is directed to file written statement and affidavit of admission/denial of documents as per law with advance copy to the opposite party, who may file replication and affidavit of admission/denial thereafter as per law.
11. Summons issued to defendant no.2 through ordinary mode and speed post received back unserved with report that no such firm at the given address.
12. Summons issued to defendant no.3 through ordinary mode received back with report of incomplete address.



13.It is submitted that the matter is coming up for hearing before the Hon'ble Court on 20.04.2023.

14.Since time is short, no order for issuing fresh summons to defendants no.2 and 3 is being passed.
