3. The present petition challenges the impugned award dated 9th September, 2020 in **CA No. 46/2019** titled ***Govind Joshi v. Sh. Ramendra Singh Baoni & Anr.*** passed by the ***Presiding Officer, Labour Court-XIX, Rouse Avenue Courts, New Delhi*** (hereinafter "***Labour Court***") by which the claim of the Petitioner/Workman under section 33C(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, has been dismissed for want of territorial jurisdiction. The workman's claim was for payment of balance of salary, gratuity, and towards retrenchment compensation. The Management was ex parte before the Labour Court.

4. The submission of Id. Counsel for the Workman is that the Management's registered office is in Delhi even though the last place where the Workman was working was in Noida. It is submitted that since the registered office of the Respondent is in Delhi, the Labour Court in Delhi



would also have jurisdiction to adjudicate the dispute.

5. Issue notice, returnable on 18th May, 2022.
