Judgment Debtor no.2 is still unserved.

Mr. Anand Varma, learned counsel appearing for the judgment debtor no.1 states, affidavit of assets shall be filed during the course of the day. A copy of the same has been handed over to the counsel for the decree holder, who seeks some time to go through the same.

It is made clear that the judgment debtor no.1 shall not encumber and / or create any third party rights with respect to the moveable and immovable assets, which are mentioned in the affidavit till the next date of hearing.

I have been informed by Mr. Manik Dogra, learned counsel appearing for the decree holder that judgment debtor no.2 has some equity shares in the company known as Global Agri System Pvt. Ltd. of which judgment



debtor no.1 is the Chairman, and a shareholder. If that be so, judgment debtor no.2 shall not create third party rights with respect to his shares in the company till next date of hearing.
