CCP(O) No.40/2021

1. The respondent no.1 (Judgment Debtor No.1) has filed the reply explaining the reasons why certain assets which were standing in his name have not been disclosed.
2. The said explanation is accepted and the above-captioned petition is dismissed.

EA No.1074/2021 (for stay)

3. The respondent no.1 has disclosed his shareholding in Tamil Nadu Mercantile Bank Ltd. The respondent no.1 has also disclosed the copies of arrangements and various communications. It appears that the respondent no.1 has instituted proceedings for recovery of certain shares. Mr. Mukhopadhaya, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent no.1



states that in the event the respondent no.1 is successful in obtaining the shares of Tamil Nadu Mercantile Bank Ltd., the injunction passed earlier would also apply to the said shares. He also states that in the event the respondent no.1 enters into any settlement with third parties, he shall also deposit the consideration for the said shares with the Registry of this Court.

4. The application is disposed of recording the aforesaid statement.
