E.A. 651/2020

1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The applicant will file the requisite attested affidavits and court fees within two weeks of the normal functioning of the Court being restored.
3. The application stands disposed of.

E.A. 650/2020

4. This is an application filed by the decree holder (DH) seeking early hearing of the enforcement petition. Learned counsel for the DH submits that the DH is moving a similar application for early



hearing in the contempt petition being CCP(O) 10/2020 and, therefore, prays that both the applications be taken up for consideration together.

5. After some arguments, learned counsel for the DH submits that since the matter is likely to come up for hearing on 24.08.2020, he does not press the present application but seeks liberty to approach the Court again in case the matter is not taken up for hearing on 24.08.2020.

6. The application is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. It is further made clear that as and when the application proposed to be moved by the DH in CCP(O) 10/2020 is listed, the same will be considered on its own merits.
