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I.A. 10331/2025-Delay of 50 days in filing the accompanying O.A.

1. By virtue of the present application under Section 5 of The Limitation Act, 1963 read with Section 151 of The Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, the defendants seek condonation of 50 days in filing the appeal against the order dated 17.01.2025 passed by the learned Joint Registrar in the present case.
