1. Allowed, subject to the Appellant filing certified copy of the Award dated 30.07.2020 within three weeks from today.
2. The Application is disposed of.

MAC.APP. 233/2022, CM APPL. 35329/2022/Condonation of delay/

3. A request for an adjournment is made on behalf of the learned Counsel appearing for the Appellant.
4. The record reflects that the Appellant has only been intermittently appearing. In fact, the Appellant has not appeared on the previous four dates of hearing i.e., 06.10.2022, 18.01.2024, 27.05.2024 and 06.02.2025. The Appeal has also been filed by the Appellant after a delay of 496 days.
5. None appears on behalf of the Respondents.
6. The record also reflects that the Respondent No. 3 has been proceeded *ex parte* on 22.09.2023, while the Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 have been



deleted from the array of parties in terms of Order dated 21.12.2022.

7. The request of adjournment made by the learned Counsel appearing for the Appellant is granted subject to the payment of costs in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- to “DHCBA Cost A/c No. 15530110179338”.

8. The Appellant shall also place on record a better Affidavit setting out the grounds for condoning the delay of 496 days, within a period of six weeks.

9. The parties shall file their respective written synopsis, not exceeding three pages each, at least three days before the next date of hearing, along with the compilation of judgments, if any, they wish to rely upon.

9.1 All judgments sought to be relied upon shall be filed with an index which also sets out the relevant paragraph numbers and the proposition of law that it sets forth.
