1. This petition has been filed by the decree holder seeking execution of a decree passed by the Dubai Courts, Civil Courts of First Instance dated April 25, 2022.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the judgment debtor herein was a resident of Dubai who was doing business of import and trade of rice in Dubai. It transpired that the judgment debtor has left Dubai and is staying in India.
3. He also states, speed post sent to him is received back with an acknowledgement 'left'. He states, he will make an attempt to serve the judgment debtor on the address given in the memo of parties.
4. He has also shown me the notification issued by the Central Government dated January 17, 2020 wherein the Central Government declared that, UAE to be a reciprocating territory for the purpose of Section



44A of the CPC, 1908 which stipulates execution of decrees passed by Courts in reciprocating territory. The notification also states that the Dubai Courts shall be superior court of that territory.

5. Issue notice to the judgment debtor through all modes including WhatsApp and e-mail returnable on March 21, 2023.
