1. Mr. S B Upadhyay, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner, submits that despite the fact that the finding of relevant fact was in the favour of petitioner, the complaint has been allowed while observing that, though, there was violation of the terms of the policy, but such violation was not substantial in nature.
2. It is apprised that when the matter was pending before the learned National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission (in short "NCDRC"), the petitioner had deposited 50% of the decretal amount, which is still lying deposited before the learned NCDRC.
3. According to instructions received by Mr. Upadhyay, so far, no Execution Petition has been filed by the defendant.
4. However, without prejudice to their rights and contentions, let the balance 50 % of decretal amount be also deposited before the learned

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Executing Commission within 10 weeks with the rider that such amount be not withdrawn by complaint till the next date of hearing.

5. Issue notice through all permissible modes as also through counsel, returnable on 15.10.2025.
