By way of the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 ('BNSS'), the petitioner seeks quashing of case FIR No. 0120/2022 dated 10.02.2022 registered under sections 420/468/471/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC') at P.S.: Sangam Vihar, Delhi ('subject FIR').



2. Mr. Shadman Ahmed Siddiqui, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits, that on a bare reading of the FIR no offence under sections 468 and 471 of the IPC is disclosed. Counsel further submits that though the transaction that is subject matter of the FIR dates back to 2016 and the FIR was registered in 2022, investigation in the matter has still not been completed.
3. Issue notice.
4. Mr. Rahul Tyagi, learned ASC appears for the State on advance copy; accepts notice; and seeks time to file status report.
5. Upon the petitioner taking requisite steps, let notice be sent to respondent No.2 by all permissible modes, returnable for the next date.
6. Let the status report/reply to the petition be filed within 06 weeks of service; rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within 04 weeks thereafter; with copies to the opposing counsel.
7. Re-notify on 18th November 2024.
