1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present appeal has been filed by the Appellant under Section 415(2) read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (*hereinafter*, 'BNSS') against the judgment dated 18th September, 2024 (*hereinafter*, 'impugned judgment') passed by Id. Additional Sessions Judge-02, South East District, Saket Courts, New Delhi.
3. On the last date of hearing, the Court directed DLSEA, South East District, to place on record the report containing details of compensation awarded to the victim's family.
4. On behalf of the DSLSEA, a report has been placed on record to the effect that the compensation of Rs. 9.5 lacs has been released to the LRs of the deceased victim on 28th January, 2026.
5. The amount is stated to have been credited to one Mr. Ronak Verma



and one Ms. Damini Verma. The exact relationship between the said persons with the deceased, and the manner in which the disbursal of compensation to these persons was ascertained, has not been mentioned in the report at all.

6. Accordingly, let the Secretary (Litigation), DSLSA file a report in this regard.
