1. Both sides pray for and are granted further four weeks time to file their respective written submissions in terms of the last order.

CM APPL. 54988/2022 -Clarification of order in W.P.(C) 692/2020

3. This is an application filed by the petitioner in W.P.(C) 692/2020 seeking clarification of the order dated 11.10.2022 passed by this Court, whereby it was directed that filing of rejoinder affidavit by the petitioner would be subject to costs of Rs.30,000/- payable to the Delhi State Legal Services Authority.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that since three petitions were taken up together for consideration, the Court intended to direct that costs of Rs.30,000/- will be paid in respect of all the three petitions as a condition for filing rejoinder. However, since he had prayed for time to file rejoinder only in W.P.(C) 692/2020, the petitioner is liable to pay costs of only Rs. 10,000/- and not Rs. 30,000/-.
5. Learned counsel for the non-applicants do not dispute the aforesaid position.
6. The application is, accordingly, disposed of by clarifying that the petitioner will be required to pay only a sum of Rs.10,000/- to the Delhi State Legal Services Authority as a condition for filing rejoinder in W.P.(C) 692/2020.
