The application stands dismissed as not pressed.

W.P.(C) 12244/2019

The present petition filed by the Management assails the award dated 11.10.2018 passed by the learned Labour Court-V, Dwarka Courts in I.D.No.1069/2016. Under the impugned award the Labour Court has after holding that the services of the respondent were illegally terminated has directed the petitioner to reinstate him with full backwages along with continuity of service and all other consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even though



sufficient evidence was led before the Labour Court to demonstrate that the respondent had upon being transferred to Sadhna Enclave voluntarily left service, the Court has rejected the petitioner's stand and has instead accepted the bald averments of the respondent.

Upon the petitioner filing process fee, issue notice to the respondent by ordinary process and speed post returnable on 27.01.2020 before the Registrar concerned for completion of service.
