ORDER

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1. With the consent of the respective counsel for the parties (as also the petitioner and the respondent no.3 who are present in person), who are present in Court, the following directions are issued:-

- (i) It is agreed that the petitioner shall meet her son, Mr. Amit Malhotra, at least once in a month for a continuous duration of 8 hours at the residence of the petitioner. The date/s of such visits shall be mutually agreed upon by the petitioner and the respondent no.3.
- (ii) The petitioner shall ensure that during the said meeting, adequate arrangements are in place to meet the medical needs of her



son, Mr. Amit Malhotra in the event of any exigency;

(iii) It is further agreed that the respondent no.3 shall endeavour to ensure that the petitioner is able to meet and spend adequate time with her son, Mr. Amit Malhotra, on festivals. The respondent no.3 assures that earnest efforts shall be made from her side to ensure that the same is done.

(iv) The petitioner shall be at liberty to arrange any doctor/medical professional to see/examine her son with a view to afford the best possible treatment to her son. However, such examination shall be done only in the presence of the respondent no.3. The date and time for the same shall also be fixed in consultation with the respondent no.3.
