The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking direction thereby quashing the impugned order dated 17.08.2019 passed by Ld. Family Courts, Shahdara District, Karkardooma Courts whereby the petitioner has been directed to pay ₹45,000/- per month, i.e., ₹35,000/- to respondent no.1 (wife) and ₹10,000/- to respondent no.2 (minor daughter) as interim maintenance.

The case of the petitioner is that pursuant to the order dated 14.03.2018 passed by the Family Court, the petitioner has been continuously paying a sum of ₹ 20,000/- in favour of the parents and an EMI of ₹ 15,000/- to the bank for the property wherein the respondent no.1 (wife) is residing.

Moreover, without any directions of the Court, the petitioner has also been paying a sum of ₹ 13,000/- to the respondent no.1 (wife) for the well being of respondent no.2 (daughter, who is 4 years old).

The petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 17.08.2019 whereby directed to pay a sum of ₹45,000/- per month as maintenance to the respondents out of his total salary of ₹95,000/- per month, as assessed, however, disputed.

Notice issued.

Let notice be served upon the respondents through all permissible modes, returnable on 25.02.2020.

Till then, operation of the impugned order dated 17.08.2019 shall remain stayed.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall continue to pay ₹ 20,000/- in favour of the parents, EMIs of ₹ 15,000/- to the bank for the property wherein the respondent no.1 (wife) is residing and ₹ 13,000/- towards the well being of respondent no.2.

Renotify on 25.02.2020.
