1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application is disposed of.

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3. Let the Plaint be registered as a suit.
4. Issue summons to the defendants to be served through all permitted modes, including electronically, returnable on 20th February, 2023 before the learned Joint Registrar (Judicial).
5. The summons to the defendants shall indicate that the written statement(s) to the Plaint shall be positively filed within the statutory period from the date of receipt of summons. Along with the written statement(s), the defendants shall also file the affidavit(s) of admission/denial of the documents of the plaintiff, without which the written statement(s) shall not be taken on record.



6. Liberty is given to the plaintiff to file the replication within the statutory period of the receipt of the written statement(s). Along with the replication, if any, filed by the plaintiff, the affidavit of admission/denial of documents of the defendants be filed by the plaintiff, without which the replication shall not be taken on record. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of any documents, the same shall be sought and given within the timelines.

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7. Issue notice.

8. On the plaintiff taking steps, let notice be served on the defendants through all permissible modes, including electronically, returnable before the Court on 20th January, 2023.

9. Let the reply(ies) to the application be filed by the defendants within a period of three weeks of receipt of the notice. Rejoinder(s) thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.
