ORDER

02.08.2024

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1. The present petition is filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking quashing of FIR No.194/2014, dated 03.04.2014, registered at police station Sangam Vihar, for offences under Sections 323/341/308/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

2. The victims are present in Court and state that they do not



wish to pursue the proceedings arising out of the present FIR against the petitioners.

3. It is pointed out that there are five accused in the present FIR and the petition is filed on behalf of the two accused persons, three of the accused persons are not appearing before the learned Trial Court and two of those accused persons have already been declared as proclaimed offenders.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the quashing is sought only in regard to the present petitioners and the case can proceed as far as the other accused are concerned.

5. He submits that the victims and the petitioners are related to each other and with the intervention of the family friends and relatives, they have settled their dispute. The victims are present in Court and on being asked, they state that they have no objection if the FIR against the petitioners is quashed.

6. Issue notice.

7. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State accepts notice and seeks time to file the status report.

8. Let the same be filed before the next date of hearing.

9. The petitioners are also present in Court and are duly identified by the Investigating Officer.

10. The petitioners and victims are exempted from personal appearance of the next date of hearing.
