1. This is an Application filed on behalf of Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 seeking release of the amount
2. Learned Counsel for the Respondents/Claimants submits that the deceased was the only bread winner of his family comprising of his wife and daughter. He submits that the Applicants are incurring approximately Rs.12,000/- per month towards the EMI of a home loan.
 - 2.1 Learned Counsel for the Respondents/Claimants submits that Respondent No. 2 is the daughter of the deceased who is suffering from a chronic disease called systemic lupus erythematosus with mesenteric vasculitis and incurring medical expenses Rs. 10,000/- to Rs. 15,000/- per month. In addition, it is contended that Respondent No. 2 is also preparing for competitive examinations and urgently require amounts for their survival.
3. Issue Notice. Learned Counsel for the Appellant accepts Notice and seeks time to file a Reply.



4. Let a Reply be filed within a period of four weeks.
 - 4.1 Rejoinder, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.
 5. In the meantime, let a sum of Rs. 15 lakhs be released to the Respondents/Claimants in accordance with scheme, as is set out in the Impugned Award.
 6. The Application stands disposed of.
