1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. Mr. Abhinav Kalia, Ld. Counsel for the Appellant submits that the process fee filed by the Appellant for effecting service upon the Respondent has not come on record and the same is under objections.
3. He further submits that the main counsel for the Appellant is hospitalized today and is thus unable to ensure his appearance before the Court.
