1. Pleadings complete.

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2. JDS and hard copies of documents filed by plaintiff as well as defendant no. 2.

3. Affidavit of admission/denial filed by defendant no. 1.

4. Hard copies of documents not filed by defendant no. 1.

5. Learned counsel for defendant no.2 further pointed out that some of the entries made on behalf of defendant no. 1 in the JDS are not in agreement with the affidavit of admission/denial, filed on behalf of defendant no. 1. At this, learned counsel for defendant no. 1 submitted that



he may be granted one more opportunity to make the correct entries in the JDS.

6. Learned counsel for defendant no. 1 further requested for one more opportunity to file hard copies of documents.

7. Learned counsel for plaintiff and learned counsel defendant no. 2 opposed the request stating that defendant no.1 is deliberately lingering on the matter and not taking any steps to complete the proceedings despite availing several opportunities and therefore, his right to file hard copies of documents may be closed.

8. Heard.

9. During arguments, no any reasonable grounds are stated on behalf of defendant no. 1 for not filing the hard copies of documents despite availing several opportunities including last opportunity given on previous date. Hence, in view of the facts and circumstances, a cost of Rs. 10,000/- is imposed upon defendant no. 1, to be deposited with DHCLSA. One more opportunity is granted to defendant no. 1, subject to payment of cost, for filing hard copies of documents and to file correct Document Schedule, on receiving afresh from learned counsel for plaintiff, within two weeks.

10. Put up for admission/denial and marking of documents on 23.09.2025.
