ORDER
19.09.2025

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I.A. 23392/2025 (u/S-151 CPC)

1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the applicant/defendant no.1 under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (hereinafter 'CPC') seeking clarification/modification of the order passed by this Court on 8th April, 2025.



2. The clarification is sought in respect of paragraphs 8 and 9 of the order dated 8th April, 2025. The relevant portion of the said order is set out below:

“8. In view of the aforesaid, the defendant no.1 shall file an affidavit placing on record the relevant part of the petition filed before the High Court of Bombay, along with the date of filing.

*9. In the said affidavit, the defendant no.1 shall address the source of finances of the defendant no.1 for the production of the movie “RNCS”. The **affidavit shall provide details of all the bank accounts** of the defendant no.1 company and their status i.e., whether they have been attached or not.*

3. Mr. Saurabh Kirpal, senior counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant submits that the aforesaid direction requiring the defendant no.1 to provide Bank Accounts was put only in the event the amount of Rs. 2.32 crores as noted in paragraph 12 of the order dated 8th April, 2025 was not paid by the defendant no.1. Since the aforesaid amount has already been paid on 22nd May, 2025, the requirement to disclose the Bank Account details is not required.

3.1. He further submits that the present application was filed as far back as on 15th May, 2025. However, the same has been listed now.

4. Mr. Amit Sibal, senior counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiff submits that the directions contained in paragraphs 8 and 9, including disclosure of the Bank Accounts of the defendant no.1, were not contingent on the defendant having paid the amount of Rs. 2.32 crores.

5. Both counsels for the parties submit that arguments are being advanced in respect of I.A. 815/2024 filed on behalf of the plaintiff under Order XXXIX Rule 2A of CPC.

6. The order in respect of which the clarification is sought was passed as far back on 8th April 2025 and therefore, it would be in the fitness of things



that the Roster Bench, which is hearing the parties on merits, may consider in the facts and circumstances of the case whether the defendant no.1 is required to give the details of its Bank Accounts.

7. Accordingly, subject to the orders of the Hon'ble Judge In-charge (Original Side), list before the Roster Bench on 28th October, 2025, *i.e.* the date already fixed.
